PA BUREAU OF DOG LAW ENFORCEMENT

WITHOUT IDENTIFICATION A LOST DOG  
*may never make it home.*

License your dog by January 1st: [www.licenseyourdogpa.com](http://www.licenseyourdogpa.com)

**Your best friend's best chance to make it home safely is to be properly licensed.**

All dogs 3 months of age or older  
Are required by Pennsylvania law to have a current dog license.

**Failure to have your dog licensed may result in a fine of up to \$300 (per dog).**

**How much does a license cost?**

Annual license fees are as follows:

**General:**

Dogs that are spayed or neutered..... \$6.50

Dogs not spayed or neutered ..... \$8.50

**Senior citizens** (65 years of age and older)

**or persons with proof of disability:**

Dogs that are spayed or neutered..... \$4.50

Dogs not spayed or neutered ..... \$6.50
