

ORDINANCE NO. 2060

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BURGESS AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF POTTSTOWN AMENDING SECTION 941, COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED, OF SUBPART (E), BLIGHTED PROPERTY REVIEW COMMITTEE, OF PART 9, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES, OF CHAPTER 1, ADMINISTRATION AND GOVERNMENT, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF POTTSTOWN, AS AMENDED, TO INCREASE THE SIZE OF THE BLIGHTED PROPERTY REVIEW COMMITTEE FROM FOUR (4) MEMBERS TO FIVE (5) MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, the Borough previously enacted an ordinance establishing a Blighted Property Review Committee pursuant to the Authority of the Urban Redevelopment Law, Act of May 24, P.L. 91, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council desires to increase the size of the Blighted Property Review Committee from four (4) members to five (5) members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Pottstown, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 941, Committee Established, of Subpart (E), Blighted Property Review Committee, of Part 9, Commissions and Committees, of Chapter 1, Administration and Government, of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Pottstown, is hereby amended to read as follows:

§941. Committee Established.

There is hereby created, effective immediately, a committee pursuant to the Act providing for blighted property removal consisting of five (5) members, as specified, by the Act and known as the Blighted Property Review Committee.

SECTION 2. In all other respects, the remaining provisions of Part 9, Commissions and Committees, of Chapter 1, Administration and Government, of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Pottstown, is hereby reenacted and reordained.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.


