Provided the committee with a copy of the traffic study/review of the intersection of Shoemaker Road and Robinson Street. In summary, the police department has recommended making no changes to the intersection. This is based on the fact that two civil engineering firms were involved with the modifications as a result of their study.

Advised the committee that he had completed a review of 818 Queen Street, Antrim's Chimney Service, and the request to restrict parking in front of the business as a loading zone. Cpl Boyce recommended restricting the parking in front of the business as a "No Parking, Loading Zone" with a time restriction of 6am – 9pm. He requested input from the committee. The primary issue that the committee members had was in regard to the time restriction. It was recommended that the time be changed from 9pm to either 6pm or 8pm.

Mr. Rhoads advised that he would like to speak with neighbors of the business to get their input and how it may affect them.

The issue will remain open until Mr. Rhoads has the opportunity to speak with neighbors.

Advised that the request for a "Loading Zone" at Flowers Evermore, North Hanover and Walnut Street, is still underway. There was conflicting information in regard to the property owner's stance on the installation of the parking restriction.
