Senior Citizens who are 65 or older ride buses for **FREE** in Pennsylvania thanks to the PA Lottery System!

- ✓ Bus passes are issued with proof of age. Acceptable documents include:
 - Armed Forces Discharge/Separation Papers, Baptismal Certificate, Birth Certificate, Veteran's Universal Access Identification Card, Resident Alien Card, Pace Identification Card, Passport/Naturalization Papers, Pennsylvania Identification Card, Photo Motor Vehicle Operator's License, Statement of Age Form, United States Social Security Administration
- ✓ Reduced fare passes are also available for disabled riders under the age of 65 who have a valid red, white, and blue Medicare card, or have a form, obtained by Borough Hall that is signed by a medical professional.
- ✓ Both free "Senior Passes" and "Reduced Fare Passes" can be obtained during regular Borough Hall hours (8:30 AM to 5:00 PM weekdays) on the third floor, Administration.
