Dear Dan:

Thank you for the opportunity to request of Borough Council an extension to the temporary approval for operation of our “Al’s Heart Warming Center” homeless dormitory.

If it is possible, we would love to see the temporary approval extended to May 31 of 2022.

PottstownLIFT Board member and attorney Paul Prince is in the process of drafting an amended ordinance for Borough Council consideration that would allow us a permanent location for the dormitory and related services. We hope to discuss this with you in the next couple of months. Even if successful though, it will take several months to go through the approval process. Moreover, the capital campaign and refurbishment to code of the selected site would makes it unlikely that we could have a permanent site ready by next Winter.

Although we would not anticipate using the temporary location at 214 N. Hanover Street continuously throughout the requested extended time period, it would give us great comfort to know that we have a contingency for next Winter.

We would be pleased if you would discuss this with the Council members and the Borough Council Solicitor to see if there is a way to accommodate this request.
