

Pennsylvania's Uniform Construction Code (UCC) adoption of the 2018 I-Codes will take effect on February 14, 2022. The accessibility requirements in Chapter 11 and Appendix E of the 2021 International Building Code took effect on January 1, 2022.

The six-month grace period (quoted below from the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act/PCCA) applies as long as contracts are signed prior to February 14th and permits are applied for within six months of February 14, 2022.

January 1, 2022, the accessibility provisions of the 2021 ICC family of codes will go into effect. This includes:
