REF: Monthly Report for May 2013

During May 2013 the Pottstown Police Department answered 1,990 calls for service. Of these calls 1,972 occurred in the Borough.

During the month we averaged 64.19 calls per day or 32.10 calls per 12 hour shift. For the year we have answered 8,632 calls. The daily average for the year is 57.17 calls per day or 28.58 calls per 12 hour shift.

During May 2012 we answered 1,894 calls. We answered 96 more calls this month than last May. This is an increase of 5.07% from last year. For the year we have answered 71 more calls than this time in 2012. This is an increase of .82%.

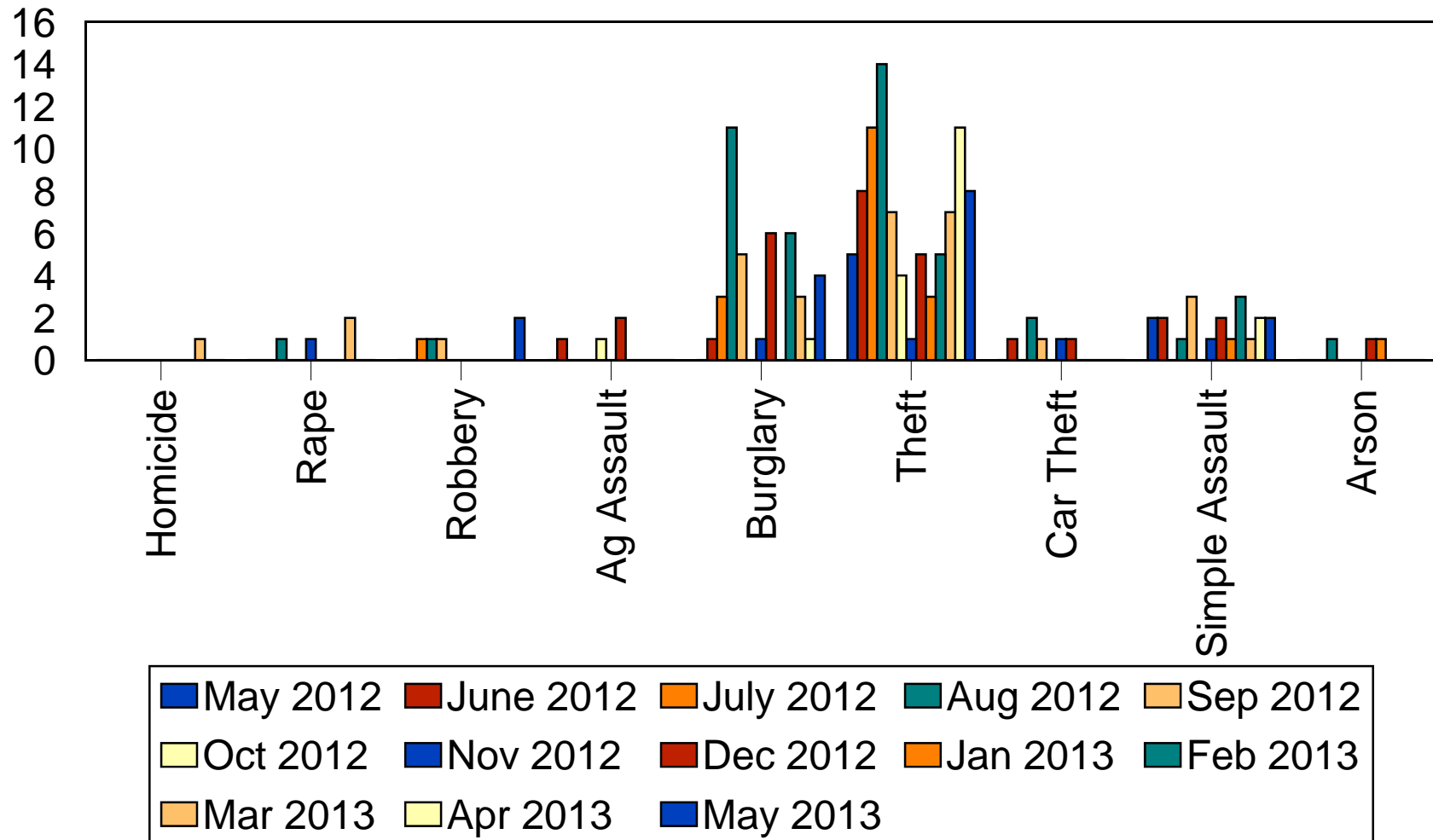
