REF: Monthly Report for April 2015

During April 2015 the Pottstown Police Department answered 1,983 calls for service. Of these calls 1,972 occurred in the Borough.

During the month we averaged 66.10 calls per day or 33.05 calls per 12 hour shift. For the year we have answered 7,370 calls. The daily average for the year is 61.42 calls per day or 30.71 calls per 12 hour shift.

During April 2014 we answered 1,779 calls. We answered 194 more calls this month than last April. This is an increase of 10.91% from last year. For the year we have answered 594 more calls than this time in 2014. This is an increase of 8.78%.

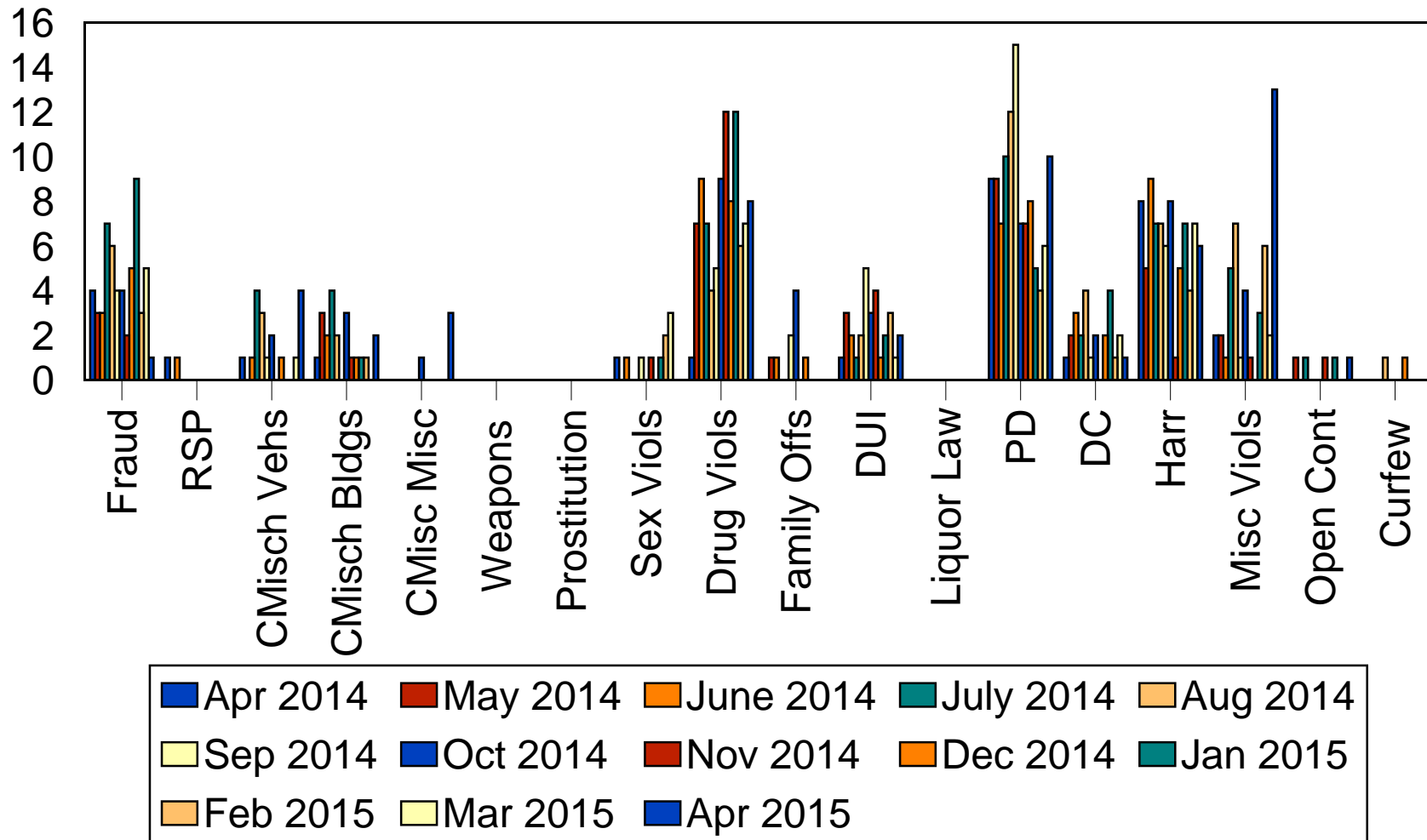
