REF: Monthly Report for May 2016

During May 2016 the Pottstown Police Department answered 2,154 calls for service. Of these calls 2,138 occurred in the Borough.

During the month we averaged 69.48 calls per day or 34.74 calls per 12 hour shift. For the year we have answered 9,991 calls. The daily average for the year is 65.73 calls per day or 32.87 calls per 12 hour shift.

During May 2015 we answered 2,215 calls. We answered 61 fewer calls this month than last May. This is a decrease of 2.75% from last year. For the year we have answered 406 more calls than this time in 2015. This is an increase of 4.24%.
