REF: Monthly Report for September 2012

During September 2012 the Pottstown Police Department answered 1,833 calls for service. Of these calls 1,822 occurred in the Borough.

During the month we averaged 61.1 calls per day or 30.55 calls per 12 hour shift. For the year we have answered 16,312 calls. The daily average for the year is 59.53 calls per day or 29.77 calls per 12 hour shift.

During September 2011 we answered 1,947 calls. We answered 114 fewer calls this month than last September. This is a decrease of 5.86% from last year. For the year we have answered 370 more calls than this time in 2011. This is an increase of 2.32%.

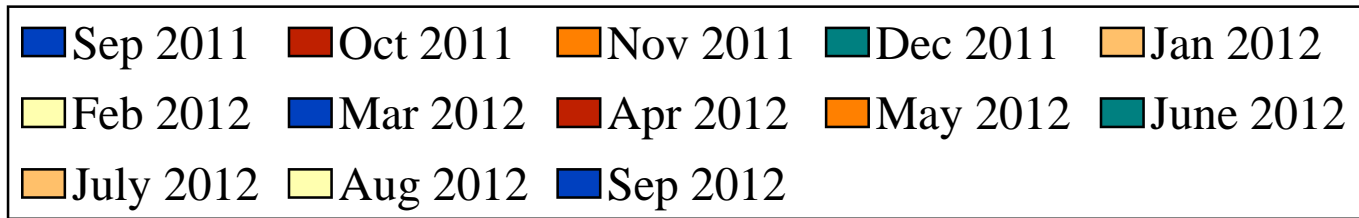
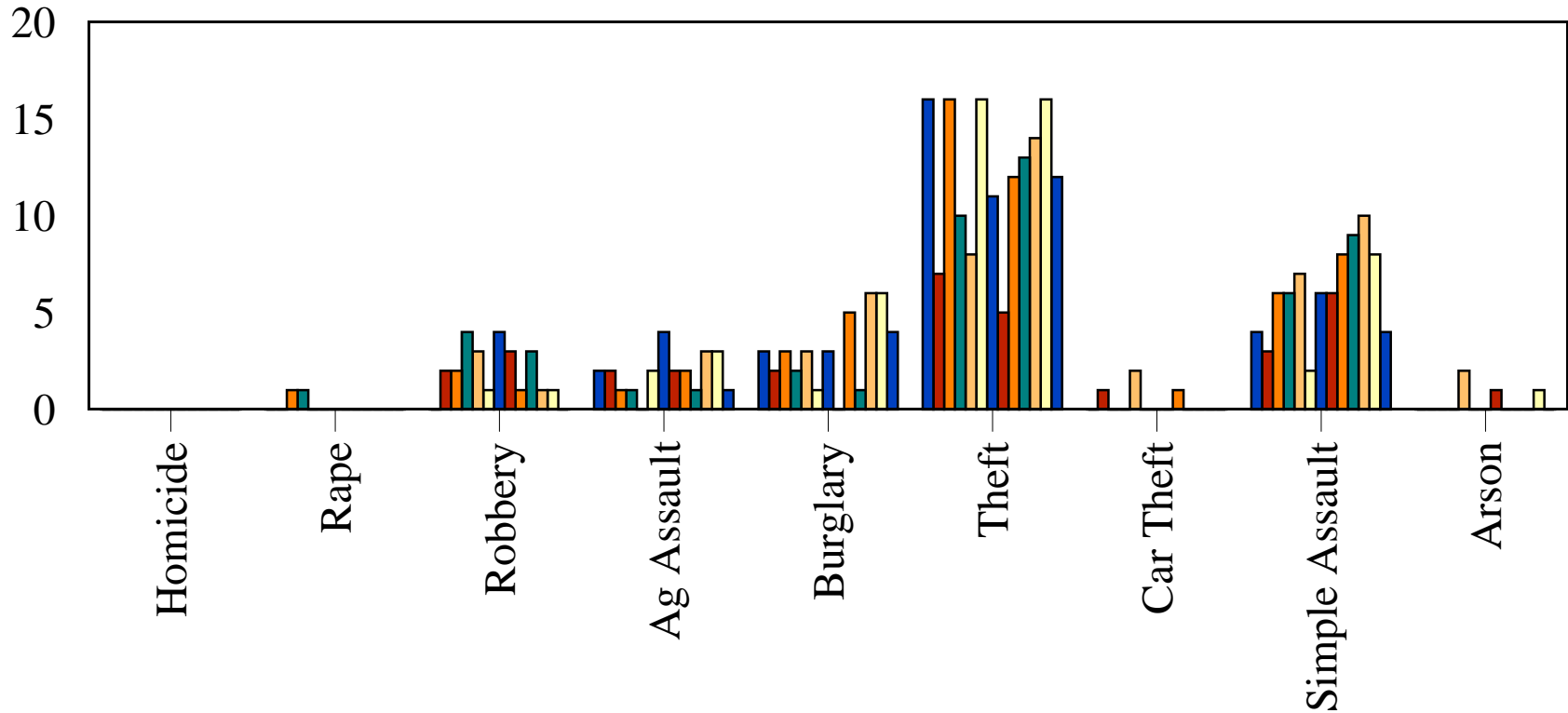
